

### ABOUT CHESTER TOWN TALL

# Chester Town Hall is a designated Grade II listed building in the heart of Chester.

After the previous exchange building was burnt down, a competition was held to build a new town hall. The bid was won by William Henry Lynn of Belfast and opened in 1869. Designed in a Gothic Revival style and echoing its neighbour, the Cathedral, the Town Hall boasts stunning interiors with glorious murals, oil paintings, stained glass windows and beautiful flooring. Today, the Town Hall has maintained it's beauty for over 150 years and proudly serves as the base for the city's Lord Mayor and civic functions. It provides space for local residents to host community and charity events and is available to hire for a number of private events.





# IMPRESSIVE SPACE IN THE HEART OF THE CITY

Conveniently located at the heart of the city and part of the newly created Northgate Development, the Town Hall sits close to a number of attractions, landmarks and historical buildings. 

# Can I serve alcohol at the Town Hall

Yes! We are a licensed premises and welcome you to serve alcohol at your event. Please contact us to discuss your specific needs and corkage rates.

### Is there on site catering available?

No. There is no onsite catering available however we do have a finishing kitchen on site, available for use for any outside caterers you may wish to bring to your event.

# Do you offer any projectors, screen, AV or PA?

Yes. Our Assembly Room has full PA, hearing loop, projection screen and projector included in the hire package. If you have further needs for your booking, contact us and we can talk through the options available.

# Do you offer tea, coffee and refreshments?

Yes. We have tea and coffee available as add-ons in all our room hires. Please contact us for more information or to discuss further light refreshments.

### Can we bring our own suppliers to Chester Town Hall?

Yes! If the required service is not intrusive by its nature, or does not require power from the venue, you are welcome to source your own suppliers such as: florists, photographers, and standalone musicians.

#### Is there a car park?

Unfortunately, the Town Hall does not have a dedicated car park. However, there are many public car parks in the near vicinity, together with metered on-street parking nearby.

#### Is there disabled access at the Town Hall?

Yes, there is disabled access which is located on Princess Street. Please press the buzzer located on the side of the entrance and our staff will be ready to assist.
